Sustainability Levy, Transfers & Private Vehicle or Boat

Terms & Conditions

Children under the age of 12 years – 50% of the per person sharing rate.

Private game drives or boat cruises are compulsory for guests travelling with children. Vehicles can be parked at Kazile boat station. A short boat cruise will transfer guests to the island.

Rate inclusions (DBB) – accommodation, dinner, breakfast, short boat cruise transfer to the island from Kazile boat station. Vat & NTB levy.

Rate exclusions – lunch, beverages, activities (game drives, bush walks, boat cruises, Sijwa Project tour), sustainability levy, personal purchases, gratuities, park fees, all road and boat transfers (please see the transfer rates above) and laundry services.

Rates are subject to change. A 30% deposit is required to confirm any reservation. Full payment of the balance is due 30 days prior to guests arrival, unless the booking is made within 14 days, in which case full payment will be required to confirm the reservation.

For all bookings cancelled between:

- 60 and 30 days prior to arrival – 50 % of the total amount will be due;
- 29 and 15 days prior to arrival – 75 % of the total amount will be due;
- 14 and 0 days prior to arrival – 100 % of the total amount will be due.
