Find us in Namibia's untapped Zambezi region; that little lush panhandle just above Botswana. We're located inside Bwabwata National Park, in the heart of KAZA – on the banks of the Kwando River and its floodplains.

Ten soulful and spacious tented suites are perched in treetops. Beautifully secluded, you'll feel as though there's nothing but you, the view, and sometimes, the passage of migrating wildlife below.

Access by Air

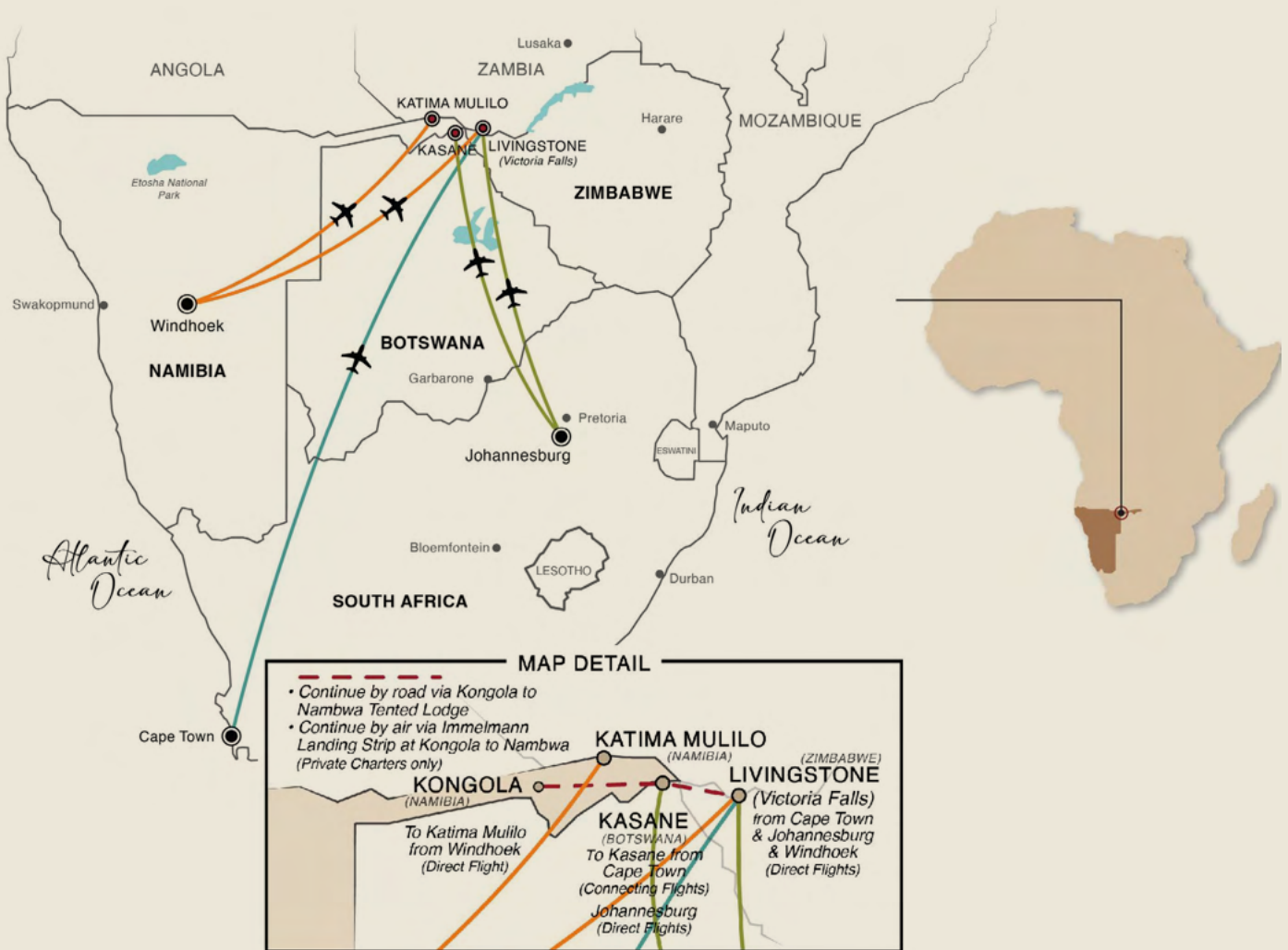
AIR CHARTER OR ROAD TRANSFER AVAILABLE FROM ALL AIRPORTS

- Vic Falls/Livingstone to Nambwa: 4-5 hrs
- Kasane to Nambwa: 3-3.5 hrs
- Katima Mulilo to Nambwa: 1.5 hrs

DIRECT ACCESS VIA AIR CHARTER

Immelman landing strip

- GPS coordinates: S 17° 46'500" E 023° 18' 300"
- Length of runway: 1 300 m
- Directions: 00927



Access by Road (2x4 & 4x4)

GPS coordinates: 17°52'31.28"S 23°19'1.46"E

ACCESS FROM DIVUNDU VIA KONGOLA

2.5 hours 215 km (2x4 friendly)

- Proceed along the B8, through the police checkpoint at Divundu until you reach the small town of Kongola.
- Reminder: Please contact the lodge when you reach Kongola so that a boat can be dispatched for your collection.
- Take a right turn onto the C49 at the Kongola Fuel Station.
- Continue south along the C49 for 8.5 km. You will reach the Sijwa Project turnoff on the right.

ACCESS FROM KATIMA MULILO VIA KONGOLA

1.5 hours 323 km (2x4 friendly)

- Nambwa Tented Lodge is located approximately 144 km west of Katima Mulilo.
- Take the B8 from Katima Mulilo towards Rundu.
- Reminder: Please contact the lodge when you reach Kongola so that a boat can be dispatched for your collection.
- At Kongola continue on the B8; turn left onto the C49 at the Kongola Fuel Station and continue south along the C49 for 8.5 km. You will reach the Sijwa Project turnoff on the right.

FROM THE SIJWA PROJECT TURNOFF

- Continue down the gravel road for 400 m; take the first left and continue along a gravel road for another 1.17 km until the road veers slightly to the left. Continue down this road for a further 987 m until you reach the Sijwa Project.
- Your vehicle can be parked safely at the Sijwa Project.
- If you contacted the lodge when you reached Kongola, there will be a boat for your transfer to Nambwa Tented Lodge. Please Note: a transfer fee will be applicable.

Access by Road (2x4 & 4x4) continued...

DIRECT ACCESS FROM WINDHOEK VIA DIVUNDU (4X4 REQUIRED)

Nambwa Tented Lodge is located approximately 1 115 km and 14 hours' drive northeast of Windhoek. It will take approximately 14 hours from Windhoek to Nambwa Tented Lodge by road travelling at a speed of 100 km/h. It will take another 45 minute drive from the Bwabwata National Park reception to Nambwa Tented Lodge. The entrance to Nambwa Tented Lodge includes 14 km of sand road. 4×4 vehicles are required for the last 14 km.

- Take the B1 from Windhoek to Otavi. At Otavi, turn right on the B10 and go northeast until Rundu. At Rundu, go east on the B8 for 200 km where you will cross the Okavango River at Divundu. You will pass through a police checkpoint. From the Divundu checkpoint you will drive 194 km to the park reception sign board on your left. You will turn right at the dirt road leading to the park reception. The park turnoff is 7 km west of Kongola and 2.3 km before you reach the police checkpoint on the bridge. If you reach the checkpoint you have gone too far.
- Once you have passed through the park reception gate, follow the green concrete road signs as well as the Nambwa signs until you reach the lodge. Remember you are now driving in one of the largest conservation areas in the world, enjoy the drive.
