Experience a different side of Namibia. Discover a different side of you.

Find us in Namibia's untapped Zambezi region; that little lush panhandle just above Botswana. We're located inside Bwabwata National Park, in the heart of KAZA – on the banks of the Kwando River and its floodplains.

Kazile Island Lodge rests on a private island on the banks of the winding, unspoilt Kwando River. Only accessible by boat, 13 Meru tents are surrounded by lush Mangosteen forest, immersing you in the sounds, scents and secrets of Mother Earth.

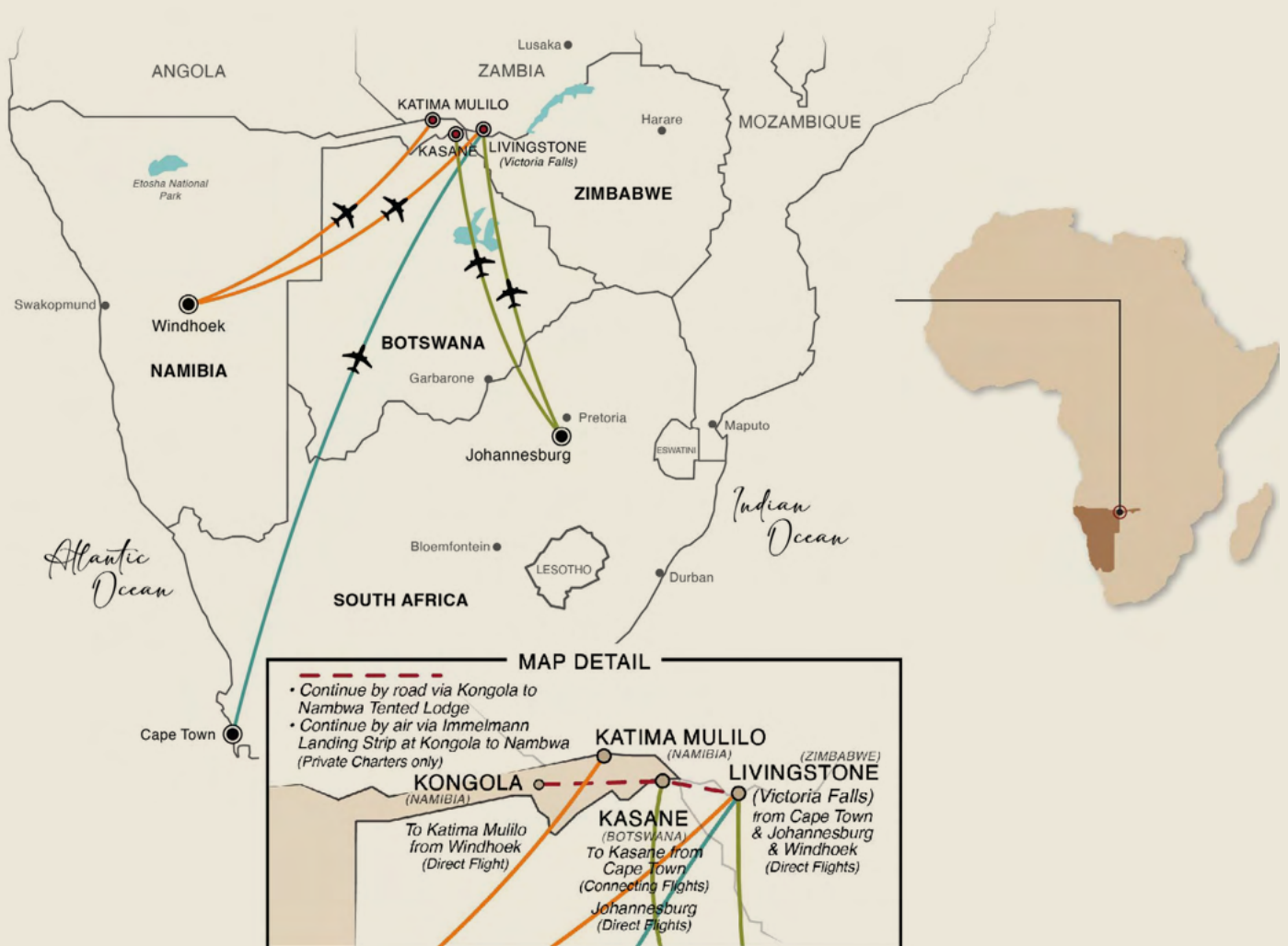
AIR CHARTER OR ROAD TRANSFER AVAILABLE FROM ALL AIRPORTS

- Vic Falls/Livingstone to Nambwa: 4-5 hrs
- Kasane to Nambwa: 3-3.5 hrs
- Katima Mulilo to Nambwa: 1.5 hrs

DIRECT ACCESS VIA AIR CHARTER

Immelman landing strip (no floats)

- GPS coordinates: S 17° 46'500" E 023° 18' 300"
- Length of runway: 1 300 m

Access by Road (2x4 & 4x4)

GPS coordinates: S 17° 54'14.9" E 23° 19'35.6"

ACCESS FROM DIVUNDU VIA KONGOLA

2.5 hours 215 km (2x4 friendly)

- Proceed along the B8, through the police checkpoint at Divundu until you reach the small town of Kongola.
- Reminder: Please contact the lodge when you reach Kongola so that a boat can be dispatched for your collection.
- At Kongola, turn onto the C49 and follow the road for about 11 km until you see the turn-off to the lodge.
- After about 2.8km on a dirt road you reach the Kazile Boat Station parking lot from where guests are transferred to the lodge by boat (5 minutes).

ACCESS FROM KATIMA MULILO VIA KONGOLA

3-4 hours 323 km (2x4 friendly)

- Take the B8 from Katima Mulilo towards Rundu.
- Reminder: Please contact the lodge when you reach Kongola so that a boat can be dispatched for your collection.
- At Kongola, turn onto the C49 and follow the road for about 11 km until you see the turn-off to the lodge.
- After about 2.8km on a dirt road you reach the Kazile Boat Station parking lot from where guests are transferred to the lodge by boat (5 minutes).

Access by Road (2x4 & 4x4) continued...

DIRECT ACCESS FROM WINDHOEK VIA DIVUNDU

Kazile Island Lodge is located approximately 1114 km and 14 hours' drive northeast of Windhoek.

- Take the B1 from Windhoek to Otavi. At Otavi, turn right on the B10 and go northeast until Rundu. At Rundu, go east on the B8 for 200 km where you will cross the Okavango River at Divundu. You will pass through a police checkpoint. From the Divundu checkpoint you will drive a further 194 km until you reach the next police check point on the Kwando River.
- You will pass through a police checkpoint, drive a further 7 km to the Kongola filling station where you turn right onto the C49.
- Reminder: Please contact the lodge when you reach Kongola so that a boat can be dispatched for your collection.
- Continue on the C49 for 11 km until the Kazile Island Lodge turnoff on the right (western side of the road). There is also a lay-bye under a big tree on the right. Turn off at the sign and follow the dirt road for 2.4 km. You will reach the river parking area where you will be met for your transfer to the lodge.
- You do not require a 4X4 for the 2.4 km dirt road to the Kazile boat station. Your car can be parked safely at the Kazile boat station. A short 5-minute boat cruise along the Kwando River will take you to Kazile Island Lodge.
